DBQfest (formerly known as Dubuquefest Fine Arts Festival) is lowa's oldest and longest-running Art Fair and Festival. Starting in 1979, DBQfest has been celebrating art, music, and culture from the very beginning. With over 40 professional and emerging artists annually, the Art & Makers fair is the festival's hallmark and one of the longest-running aspects of the festival.
